  3. **Clarity:** If it's confusing, rewrite it
  4. **Actionability:** Always include next steps
  5. **Transparency:** Disclose everything

## SEO Strategy

### Keywords Targeted

- Long-tail Canadian-specific queries

### Content Optimization

- Descriptive headings (H2, H3)
